SSVP Ltd. is an affiliate of the Society of St Vincent de Paul (National Council of Singapore) (which is also a registered charity since 1961).

A registered charity and an Institution of a Public Character (IPC), funds raised by SSVP Ltd. will be used to cover operational costs and expenses of select centrally operated nationwide programmes and services including the Community Services Office (CSO) and Milk & Diapers (MaD) Programme as well as new Social & Development Programmes that will be implemented in future to better address the complex needs of our Friends-In-Need (FINs).

The CSO has social work practitioners who assist FINs with more complex issues and play an essential role in helping them to stand on their own feet again to lead resilient and dignified lives. The MaD Programme provides nutrition for babies during their crucial development from birth to three years old as well as diapers.

We serve the low-income and disadvantaged in Singapore, regardless of their creed, ethnicity, or gender.
