SSVP (National Council of Singapore) was established as a registered charity in 1961. SSVP Singapore serves 3,500 low-income and vulnerable individuals whom we call our Friends-in-Need (FIN) from 2,300 families in Singapore to help them lead resilient and dignified lives.

Our FINs are supported by some 750 SSVP members and volunteers as well as Social Work Practitioners (SWP) from our Community Services Office. We befriend and journey with our FINs and collaborate with relevant social service agencies to provide the holistic support needed to help them to stand on their own feet again for a better future.

HOW WE CAN HELP?



Befriending + Home Visits



We visit, journey and help FINs with financial and other essential material assistance (provisions/ medical & transport subsidy) as well as befriending support.

Community Services Office*



Our Social Work Practitioners provide comprehensive assistance, developing care plans and collaborating with relevant SSAs to provide holistic care.

Education Support



We provide tuition assistance and mentor the young to instill good values, as well as bursaries for students taking higher education courses.

Informational Support



We liaise with other organisations that can help and provide Information about other sources of help for our FINs.

Milk & Diapers Programme*



We provide milk and diapers for babies during their crucial development from birth to three years old.

St. Vincent Home

In partnership with Catholic Welfare Services, this shelter is for those above 60 years old on public assistance, whom can independently manage daily activities but do not have anyone to care for them.
