The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SSVP), a lay Catholic mission, was introduced to Singapore in 1883. Subsequently, SSVP (National Council of Singapore) was established as a registered charity in 1961. Our members, known as Vincentians, befriend and journey with the poor and marginalised whom we call our Friends-In-Need (FIN) — regardless of their race, nationality and religion — bringing them hope to lead resilient and dignified lives.

SSVP has evolved over the years to its contemporary presence with 31 Outreach Centres including SSVP Conferences located in 29 Catholic Churches as well as at SSVP House and Agape Village.

In Singapore, a Conference was set up at the Church of the Good Shepherd in 1883. After World War II, the late Monsignor H. Berthold established the Singapore chapter of SSVP with the late Messrs. Joseph Ee Peng Liang and Michael Tan Meng Chew on 8 December 1951 with Monsignor Berthold as the first Spiritual Director.
