Who We Are




A rchdiocesan Commission for the Pastoral Care of Migrants & Itinerant People (ACMI) is a charity organisation commissioned by the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Singapore to serve all migrants through welcoming, protecting, promoting and integrating them into our community – regardless of socioeconomic status and religion. Through journeying with migrants, we aim to also serve their pastoral needs. We adopt values which are rooted in our Catholic teaching and are instrumental in the development of migrants and collaborative efforts with stakeholders and agencies.

The role of ACMI is to serve the migrant community through empowering them to care for their own needs, enabling them to discover their potentials, promoting personal growth and fostering social inclusion and cohesion within the foreign and local communities.

How We Support Migrants

We aim to help migrants in Singapore meet their emotional and spiritual needs. Our ministries include Case Management & Pastoral Care, Skills Development, Outreach & Engagement and Pastoral & Formation.

Skills Development

Identifying that there was and is a great need to empower Migrant Domestic Workers (MDWs), the team at ACMI's Skills Development ministry created courses and constantly looks for new ones that will enhance MDWs lives in Singapore. Through the gaining of skills and knowledge, MDWs can build confidence and self-worth.

As MDWs are away from their family and home, we aim to help them build communities and feel welcomed, cared for and supported by their friends and the ACMI family.

Students from the Skills Development courses may also contribute back to the local migrant communities by becoming trainers themselves after they graduate.

Pastoral & Formation



As a Catholic organisation, pastoral care is the hallmark of ACMI ministries. We strive to give pastoral care in all areas of our services to reflect the love of God and care of the Church for the migrants. Guided by Catholic Social Teaching, we work for the integral human development which distinguishes us from private charity or social work.

Our programmes are carried out through workshops, retreats, liturgical gatherings and fellowships, in collaboration with different partners and collaborators, such as archdiocesan organisations, parishes, migrant communities, schools and individual volunteers.

The Pastoral & Formation ministry is focused on promoting holistic care through human formation, values formation, social formation and psychoemotional, moral and spiritual formation.

Fostering social inclusion and cohesion is one of the roles of our Outreach & Engagement ministry. We aim to facilitate the fostering of friendship bonds and help create a better understanding between the local and migrant communities. This aids in forming a social support network which enables individuals to contribute to the community meaningfully.


With better understanding of employmentrelated concerns through engagement with migrants, ACMI develops purposeful workshops and activities for migrants so that they are equipped with the relevant skills and knowledge.

Some of our other Outreach & Engagement activities include adopting a dorm managed by a parish, reaching out to migrant workers in the dormitories and distributing care packs and food, bringing migrants to places of interests, and organising a cook- or bakea-meal programme where volunteers can cook or bake for migrants.

The Case Management & Pastoral Care ministry aims to help migrants and motivate them to commit to transforming their lives in a holistic manner.

The team gives support to migrant families or individuals in areas of counselling, legal, shelter, education and other assistance to ensure that their dignity, safety and security are protected at all times.

Case Management & Pastoral Care has always been a crucial part of ACMI's work for migrants. With our Migrant Helpline and an active team that addresses each case personally, we strive to provide dedicated support for each individual, be it a foreign domestic worker, a migrant worker, or transnational families in Singapore.
